COLORFUL FANS

- Outline the arched shape of a fan with a light pencil on a piece of card stock.
- Use Crayola® Watercolors to paint a design within the fan shape and paint the craft sticks. Allow the paint to dry completely.
- Add accents to the dried fan with Crayola Supertips Markers or Crayola Glitter Glue. Allow it to dry.
- Cut out the shape of the fan.
 - Ask an adult to help you create a hole in the ends of the craft sticks. Secure the craft sticks together with a fastener.
 - Glue the fan to the craft sticks.
 - When dry, carefully crease the card stock to fold up the fan.
 - To complete the gift, wrap the door hanger and make a personalized card.

SHOW YOUR SCHOOL SPIRIT



- Create your own team-wear on any fabric, such as shirts, hats, canvas shoes and shoelaces, or hair ties.
- Use Crayola® Erasable Colored Pencils to sketch a design onto the item you selected. Consider using your school mascot, logo, or initials to create an original drawing. Add stars, your name, or your class graduation year.
- Once you've completed your sketch design, use Crayola Fabric Markers to draw your design onto the fabric. Air-dry overnight before wearing.
- To make decorative hair ties cut a rectangle of plain, light-colored cloth about 4 inches by 6 inches. Sketch a design for your hair ties onto the fabric. Use dots, stripes, swirls, checks, hearts, stars, moons, flowers, or any pattern you like.
- Once you've sketched your design, use Crayola Fabric Markers to draw your design onto the fabric. If the cloth is heavy, design both sides and let it air-dry overnight.
 - Fold the fabric in half lengthwise. Holding the fabric on the fold, cut strips up to, but not through, the fold to form fringe.
 - Open the fringed material and scrunch it together in the center to form a bow. Tie it securely around the center with colorful string or a rubber band.

SIMPLY SHAPES COLLAGE

- Cut sponges into interesting shapes.
- Cut Crayola® Construction Paper into larger versions of the sponge shapes.
- Pour various colors of Crayola Kid's Washable Paint into plastic containers.
- Dampen a sponge with water and then dip it into the paint.
- Gently press the sponge onto matching cut piece of construction paper.
- Repeat until you have printed paint onto all of your pre-cut shaped paper.
- Allow the paint to dry.
- Glue your shapes onto a large piece of construction paper to create your collage.

TRAVEL TO THE FUTURE

- Imagine yourself traveling to a city in the future. How do you get from one place to another?
- On white paper, use Crayola® Washable Markers to draw a picture of you using transportation you imagine is available in

the future. What does the vehicle look like? Where would you go?

- What do you imagine you will wear in the future? Use scissors to cut fabric for clothing and attach the fabric with glue.
- To add more color, use Crayola Washable Watercolors to tint areas of your drawing. Use plenty of water with a small amount of paint for a light wash, or less water and more paint for darker, more saturated colors. Dry flat.
